Scholarship Program

The Central PA chapter of HIMSS (CPA HIMSS) will award scholarships to qualified candidates at the Student Workforce Development and Training Conference, which will be held at the Harrisburg University of Science and Technology on April 20, 2016. The purpose of this scholarship program is to provide a qualified student with financial assistance toward tuition and/or books.

The number and amount of the 2016 scholarships are:

- One for \$1000 to Associate or Certificate program applicants
- One for \$1500 to Four-year or Postgraduate program applicant

In order to qualify to apply for the scholarship the prospective student must:

- be enrolled in associate degree program or Certificate program or an accredited four-year college for a bachelor's or master's degree program related to or part of the health information technology industry.
- be a student or regular member of HIMSS and CPA HIMSS in the year of his/her application.

Evaluation of will apply the following criteria:

1. Committee participation: Committees are formed to help plan events, activities, or other work important to the local chapter.
2. Chapter Event Attendance: There are local chapter events to enhance and foster the awareness and education of the local chapter.
3. Chapter Event Planning: Planning support of chapter events is very important especially since we are a volunteer organization.
4. Essay: Applicants will draft an essay that outlines goals for how they will utilize their education within Health IT
